Annual Report

The Examination department at HNIMR consist of Chief Exam Officer, teaching staff and Nonteaching members. The committee works for smooth functioning and conduct of Examination. The teaching learning evaluation is the most important part of MBA curriculum. The CBCS Pattern adopted by the institute offers choice based credit system to the students and to earn credit based on their performance. The number of credits earned by the student reflects the knowledge or skill acquired him / her. Each course is assigned a fixed number of credits based on the contents to be learnt & the expected effort of the student. The grade points earned for each course reflects the student's proficiency in that course.

The outcome based evaluation system effectively used blooms taxonomy in question paper pattern as well as other components of evaluation. The students along with having domain knowledge have advanced cognitive learning abilities as analysing, Application and synthesizing.

The evaluation methods consists of individual and group assignments and activities based on subject knowledge, creativity, use of technology and research.

Faculty members use combination of evaluation method for their respective subjects. The rubrics are used by the faculty members as a coherent set of criteria's for student's performance at various levels. The faculty members were trained through FDPs on their respective subjects for understanding the new curriculum, syllabus and outcome based teaching and evaluation by SPPU.

The Institute followed various ICT based practices during the Covid 19 period. The Google classroom was effectively used during period for streaming various study material and e-resources. The presentations, group discussions were effectively conducted through Google meet platform. The class test, written assignment and internal exam papers were scanned and submitted by student on Google classroom. The Dissertation internal Viva was conducted online.

The faculty evaluate the students and also give feedback about their performance. The results of the assessment are mailed to the students.

The examination for the last term began on 11th August 2021 and ended by 2nd September 2021.180 students appeared for examination out of which 174 have passed and 154 students have received first class with distinction, 19 students have received first class and only one student has higher second class.
