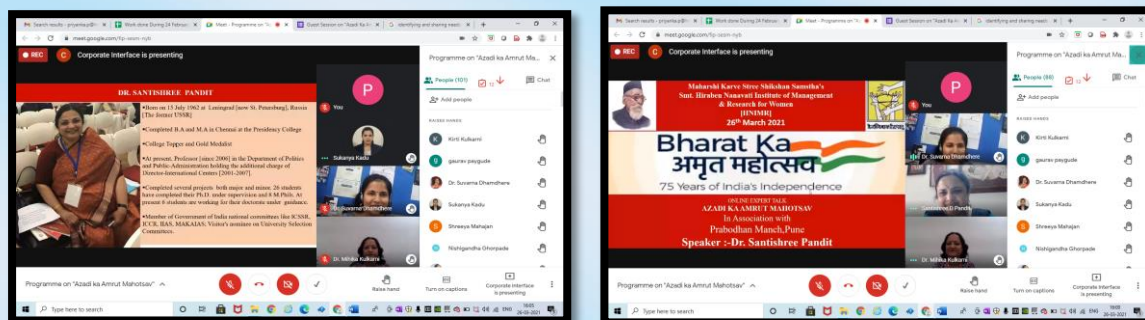

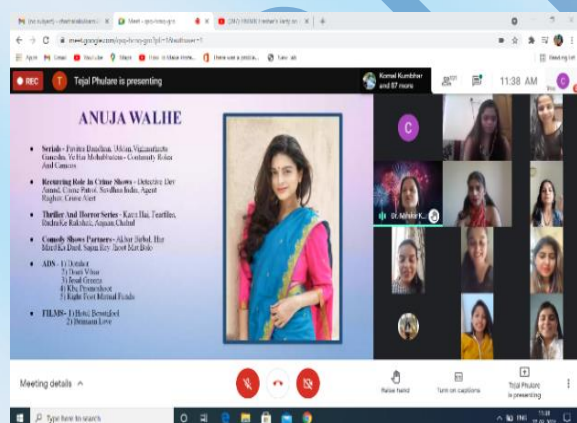

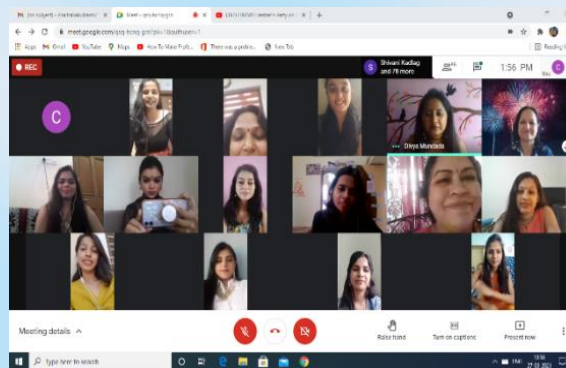
Three winners were selected by the judge Ms. Anuja Walhe Ma'am. The winners were as follows:

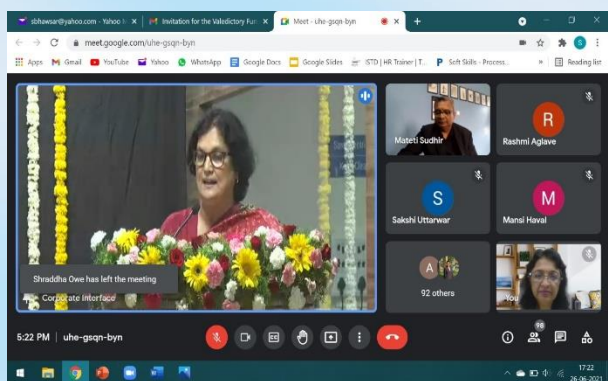

## ❖ TREE PLANTATION

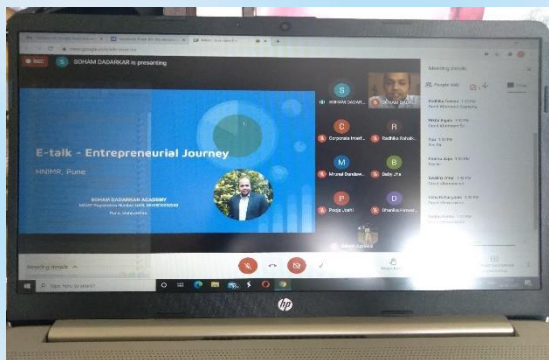

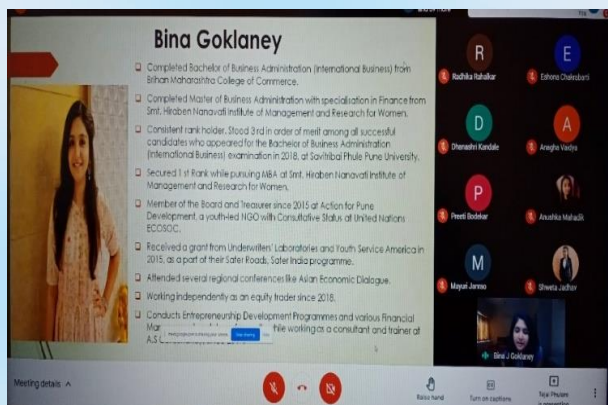

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Chapter-wise download of E-books in PDF & E-PUB.

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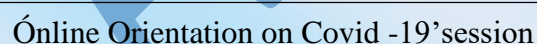
Newly Launched Mobile App – Access database on the move.

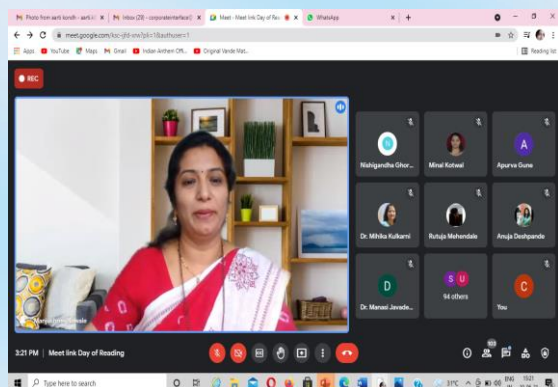

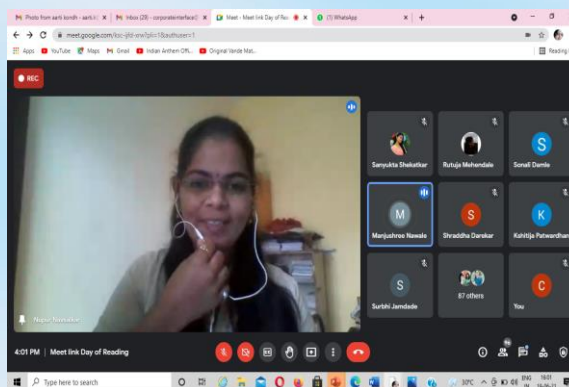
