Priyadarshini ma'am talked about how environment has got affected since last so many years due to the birth of different businesses and industries.

She has started her session with reference of history. She gave the students all the information about Technology innovation, Discovery innovation, Steam engine innovation, Deforestation due to steam machines etc. also ma'am gave the reference of how British

came with East India Company and many other European invaders broke down all the local businesses of India. She then explained how planet and people along with businesses had changed throughout different centuries like 19th , 20th , and 21st century.

In the second half she has talked about how labor laws came in 20 th century, how slavery abolished in Europe first, conflict of Environment vs. Development etc. Also, she warned students saying that “ Next couple of years are going to be crucial, we have to pay back”.

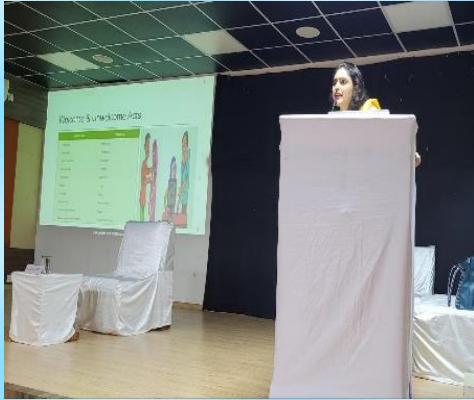


**Glimpse of the session**

It was a very informative and useful session for the students as the trainer focused on how to access EBSCO database e-resources in campus and remotely. He engaged the students with Quiz and Q&A.

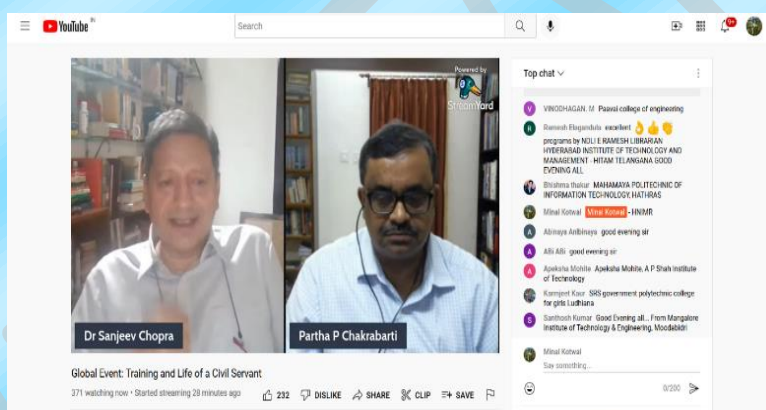

improves decision making process. It makes student a good orator and helps in overall personality development.

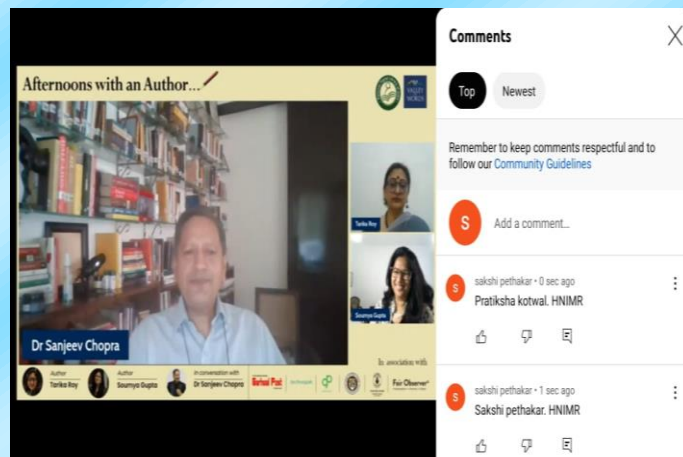

### ● **“Reading Day”**

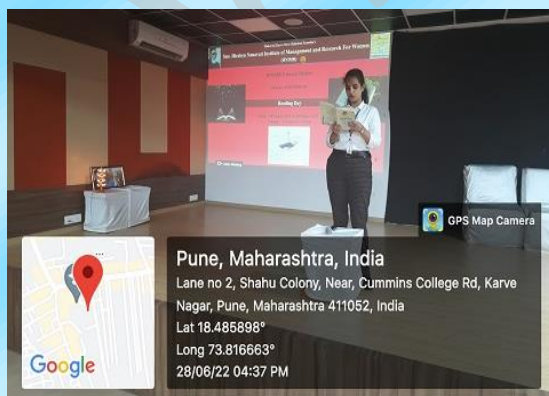
Reading Day was conducted for students of HNIMR on importance of reading from 28<sup>th</sup> June 2022 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022.
