Report on the Study on the Cigarette Smoking and Alcohol Drinking Behaviors of Migrant Adolescents and Residential Young Adults

A group of 6 students from HNIMR conducted a survey on the Cigarette Smoking and Alcohol Drinking Behaviors of Migrant Adolescents and Residential Young Adults in collaboration with BKWSRC. The survey aimed to identify and address the cigarette smoking and alcohol drinking behaviour of migrant adolescents and young adults. Migrant adolescents often face unique stress related to migration, which can influence their smoking and drinking behaviour. The students visited nearby areas to gather data on issue.

They interviewed targeted individuals aged 15-26 in Pune, with a diverse representation from different localities to gain a comprehensive understanding of the challenges. The survey findings were compiled into a detailed report that highlighted the key issues and proposed solutions.

The report was shared with BKWSRC and local government authorities to facilitate the implementation of necessary interventions. HNIMR's involvement in this social awareness initiative demonstrates its commitment to social responsibility and its efforts to bridge the gap between academia and community development.
