Examination Report

The Bloom's Taxonomy was effectively applied in the question paper format and other aspects of the outcome-based evaluation system. Along with having subject knowledge, the students also possess advanced cognitive learning skills like analysing, applying, and synthesising. Individual and group assignments and activities based on subject knowledge, creativity, technology use and research make up the evaluation process. The students are given an explanation of the credit system which comprises full credit and half credit courses, the pattern of evaluation and the components of concurrent evaluation. An academic calendar with a thorough schedule of the SPPU exams is provided to the students.

For each of their particular subjects, faculty members use a combination of evaluation techniques. The faculty members utilize the rubrics as a consistent set of standards for students' performance at different levels. Through FDPs, the faculty members received training in outcome-based teaching. Throughout this academic year, the Institute utilised a variety of ICT-based initiatives. The professor has a discussion with the students regarding their test responses and the evaluation criteria. During the academic year, tests and evaluations were successfully administered online utilising Google Classroom and other digital tools. The Google classroom served as an useful repository for a variety of e-resources and study materials. During class time, presentations and group discussions were successfully carried out. Students scanned and uploaded their written assignments, internal exams, and class tests to Google Classroom. The professors assess the students' work and provide feedback on it. Students are informed of the assessment's findings.

On 23rd and 24th Jan 2024, an internal SIP viva for MBA second-year students specialising on finance, human resources, marketing, operations and supply chain management and business analytics was planned and conducted. The final term SPPU examinations started on May 8th, 2024, and it ended on June 21st, 2024. 203 students registered for the exam, and 177 of them passed. Of those, 25 received first class with distinction, while 143 received first class. The pass percentage of final year student was 87.
