The Community Development Cell (CDC) of MKSSS's Smt. Hiraben Nanavati Institute of Management and Research for Women (HNIMR) organized a visit to Aniket Sevabhavi Sanstha – School for Special Children on 27th February 2026. A total of 72 MBA students participated in the visit.

The main objective of the visit was to create awareness about inclusive education and to provide students with first-hand experience of working with differently-abled children in a supportive and engaging environment. During the visit, HNIMR students actively conducted and supported a variety of creative and recreational activities including thread painting, drawing, dance and origami.

All the special children enthusiastically participated in each of the activities. The sessions were designed to encourage creativity, coordination, expression and joyful learning. The interaction between HNIMR students and the special children created a warm and positive atmosphere and helped build mutual understanding and emotional bonding.

Students also interacted with the school staff and gained insights into the functioning of a special school, teaching methods, and the importance of patience, care and individualized learning
