### **Report:**

The Community Development Cell (CDC) of MKSSS's Smt. Hiraben Nanavati Institute of Management and Research for Women (HNIMR) conducted a field-based survey on "Sound and Air Pollution" at Sanskar Mandir College(BCom), Warje-Malwadi on 10th February 2026. The primary objective of the survey was to understand the level of noise and air pollution in the surrounding college area and to sensitize students towards environmental protection. Students collected primary data through a structured questionnaire using a Google Form and interacted with students. The survey focused on identifying major sources of noise such as traffic and construction activities, as well as air pollution sources including vehicular emissions and dust. Participants also shared their perceptions regarding health issues, disturbance in concentration, and the need for green cover and awareness initiatives. The activity provided students with practical exposure to environmental data collection and helped them understand the real-life impact of pollution on daily life and academic environments. The survey also emphasized awareness programs to reduce pollution and promote sustainable practices. The activity was conducted under the guidance of Dr. Priyanka Singh, Director, HNIMR and was coordinated by Dr. Kamlakar Munde and Prof. Ranjana Gogate, along with student volunteers.
