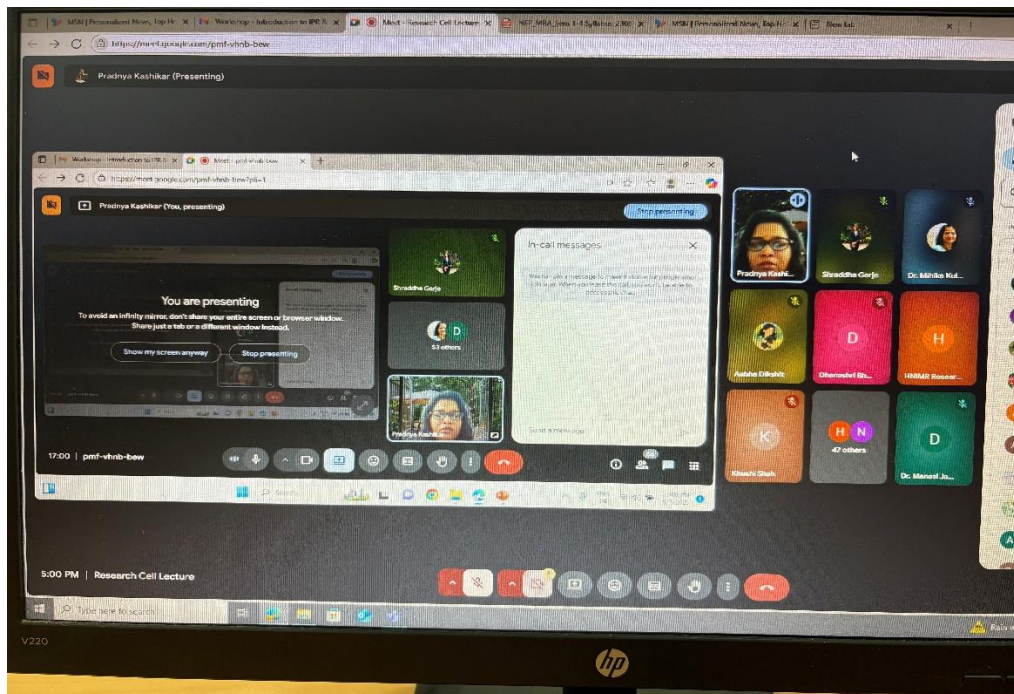

- Apply ethical writing practices and structure their OJT reports effectively, ensuring clarity, awareness of plagiarism, professionalism, and respect for confidential information.

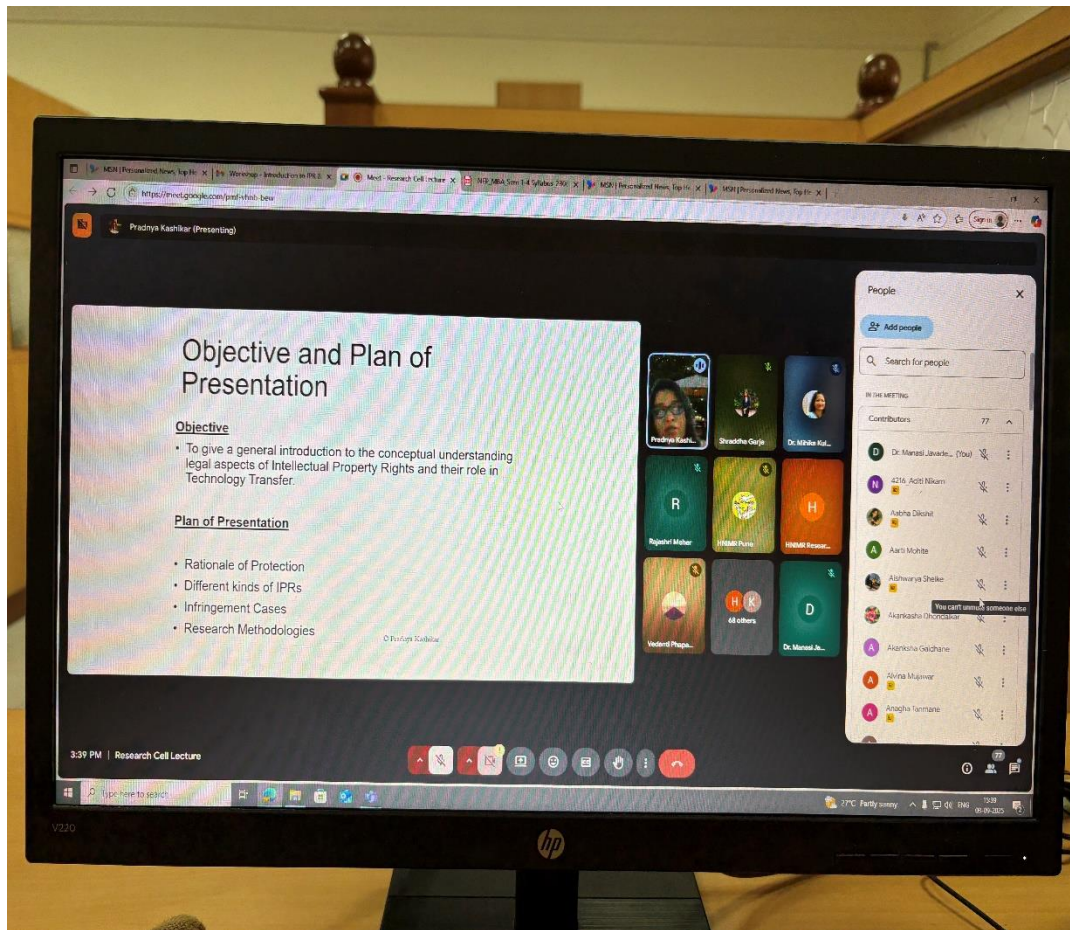
